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Aspects of oil shale and other geologically associated energy sources for the Piceance, Uinta, and Green River Basins in the Western United States

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The Piceance, Uinta, and Green River Basins have received attention for the oil shale in geologic formations to depths of about 2000 feet. This presentation shows the other energy resources available in these basins. What kind of new programs are being offered that can combine all or some of the energy resources so that they all can be utilized at timed intervals? This paper uses GIS and Autocad tools to show spatial relationships between the energy resources from an objective viewpoint, to provide information about how all energy resources can be utilized and can complement each other. The objective is that energy companies, private citizens, federal governments, state governments, and other involved parties will work together to meet the energy needs of the present and future.
